- Based in Copenhagen, Denmark
- A joint venture owned by Deutsche Bahn (D) and Green Cargo (S)
- A part of DB Schenker Rail a substantial European rail freight transportation network
- Transports almost 300,000 wagons and more than 6 million tonnes per year – which is the equivalent of 650 fully loaded lorries each day all year long
- We have more than doubled the turnover per employee in a turnaround carried out since 2001
- We have invested almost 100 mill. euro in new locomotives for cross border traffic



The 'green' corridor


- The environmentally friendly freight transport solution

- Road transport accounts for 72% of that







Rail freight by far the most eco friendly





